# Difference Between MOPS & MyCPD



MOPS	MyCPD
Paper based	Online program
5 year cycles	Annual cycles
General program	Personalised
Reactive	Proactive
Points	Credits
Manual calculation of points	Time efficient – automatic
Recording of activities	Requires planning, recording, reflecting
Requirement of 60 points/yr	Requirement of 100 credits/year
Annual Statements	Interim statement available online anytime

# MyCPD Framework



## Based on 6 categories

Educational Development, Teaching and Research

Group Learning Activities

Self Assessment Programs

Structured Learning Projects

Practice Review & Appraisal

Other Learning Activities

# Framework



- **Prospective & retrospective entering of activities**
- **No compulsory category**
- **Bonus credits for reflection**
- **Automatic submission of credits (after due date)**
- **5% audit each year**

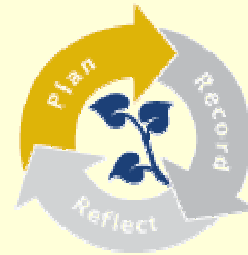

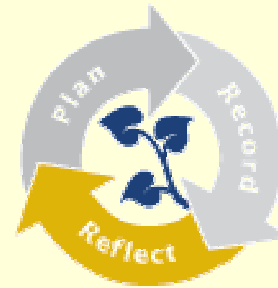

# Reflection – Add Learning Outcome



## Reflection i

(Thinking about how this activity affects your personal, professional development or practice)

### Learning Outcome Stem:

I am aware of

### Learning Outcome Conclusion:

a potential gap in my knowledge or skill  
new evidence relevant to my practice  
new skill relevant to my practice

### \*Learning Outcomes:

I have confirmed my knowledge or skill are up-to-date

# Reflective Comments – Questions to ask



## Examples of a few helpful questions include;

- How will this activity enhance my practice?
- How can I integrate new learning into my practice?
- How did it help maintain my competencies?
- How will this help me take better care of patients?
